MAKERS, BAKERS & GROWERS COMPETITION

Your chance to show off your talents – whether that's arts & crafts, baking, gardening or all four!

The Competition will take place on the Sunday in The Hut in the Adventure Playground. Entries can be dropped off from 9.30 – 11.30 am

In addition to winners in each class this year will include:

The Amanda Deckker Best in Baking Cup for one overall winner in the 'Baking Beauties' class.

The Vicar's Cup for the Best in Show across all classes.

Details of all the classes and the entry form are below.

CHILDREN

Classes are open to all ages and will be displayed and judged together but certificates will be awarded for the best entries in each age group. Age groups – pre-school and reception years, KS 1, KS2, KS3.

Entry for all children's age groups is free so please make as many entries as you can 'create'.

Class	Description	Notes
C1	Grow something edible using a recycled container.	e.g. salad cress in a hummus tub, radishes in a vegetable tray, lettuce in an old wine crate.
C2	A flower arrangement in a jam jar	This will be judged on the arranging so flowers may be homegrown, bought, artificial, homemade or any combination.
C3	Any work of art	Can be a model, a drawing, collage, painting textile or print out of a digital picture. Models can be made from any medium including balloons, pipe cleaners, plasticine, plaster, Lego or junk, etc. Models should have a footprint no larger than 30 cm ² and other entries should be no larger than A3.
C4	One or more animals made from fruit and/or vegetables	

ADULTS AND TEENS

Adult and teen entries will be displayed and judged together but where there are a sufficient number of entries certificates may be awarded for the best entries in each age group

An entry fee of £1 per entry is payable, capped at £5 per entrant– further entries may be made but no further fee will be payable. More than one entry can be submitted in the same class.

JAMS & 'JUICES'

Please make sure to include a note stating the flavour and ingredients for all entries.

Class	Description	Notes
P1	Any sweet preserve	e.g. jam, marmalade, curd, jelly, etc
P2	Any pickle or chutney	
P4	A non-alcoholic beverage	To be presented in a screw top bottle
P5	An alcoholic beverage	To be presented in a screw top bottle.

BAKING BEAUTIES

Class	Description	Notes
B1	A cake baked in a tin (sandwich or loaf)	Decoration optional
B2	Six of any type of small cake	e.g. cupcake, muffin, etc
B3	Brownies & cookies	
B4	Perfect pies – sweet or savoury	e.g. quiche, apple, etc
B5	Bread ‘basket’	Any type of bread or scones

CREATIVES CORNER

Class	Description	Notes
A1	Any item made from recycled materials	Any medium is acceptable e.g. metal, wood, textiles, metal, plastic, paper/card. To be submitted with an anonymous note stating what it is and what it was.
A2	Any hand-worked textile item	Embroidery, patchwork, knitting, crochet, weaving, macrame, etc. or a decorated item of bought clothing or an accessory e.g. a decorated t shirt or screen printed tote bag
A3	A picture in any medium except photography	Collage, painting, drawing, print of a digital work of art, etc.
A4	Our neighbourhood photograph – ‘All Creatures Great & Small’ - Stockwell wildlife or pets	Can be printed in colour or monochrome on any paper but should not exceed A4 in size.

GARDEN GLORY

Class	Description	Notes
G1	A rose – to be judged solely on scent	May be a single head or a spray on a single stem
G2	A rose – to be judged solely on appearance	May be a single head or a spray on a single stem
G3	My favourite flower in bloom	Any flower except roses
G4	A bunch of home-grown herbs	May be tied or in a jam jar
G5	A flower arrangement in a jam jar	Flowers must be home-grown
G6	Free flower arrangement – max 40cm ²	Flowers may be home grown or bought and any container may be used. Please do not use oasis.
G7	A house plant to be judged on foliage and/or flowers	Any plant in any container nor to exceed a 40cm ² footprint.
